While Bitstream Charter is one of the most beautiful open-source serif fonts out there, its upper case "E" and "F" have serifs that are too large. To wit:

EFÉ**EÉ**F*EÉF*

When hinted by TTFAutohint, this causes the "F" to look almost like a "P", and the "E" to look like a "P" with a stem when rendered at body text sizes. That in mind, I whipped up Fontforge and reduced the size of the serifs in just these two letters:

EÉF**EÉF**EÉF

While this gives the typeface a little less character, it also makes it more readable — both on the screen and to a lesser extent in print.
